Roles and Responsibilities Local 196 EDLC Delegate

Elected for a 2-year term.



Role: The delegate shall be responsible for attending monthly Edmonton District Labour Council (EDLC) meetings. Members must uphold the highest professional standards in all manners of communication and behaviour in representing UNA, Local 196.

Responsibilities:

- Attend monthly meetings. Meetings typically occur the third Monday of every month at 1900h, unless otherwise posted. Delegates can attend meetings either in-person or by Zoom.
- Participate in monthly meeting discussions and attend related EDLC events, such as the annual EDLC Labour Day BBQ and Food Bank Volunteer shift.
- Committee participation is unpaid; delegates will be compensated by being funded to attend the Spring EDLC Labour School. Funding to include registration, salary (LOA or expense claim) and parking. Delegate funding will be contingent on meeting attendance. The number of meetings delegates must have attended to be eligible will be determined by the Local Executive.
- If delegates cannot attend a meeting, they must provide advance notification to <u>office@edlc.ca</u>
- Committee members are encouraged to attend Local meetings.
